GED TESTING REQUIREMENTS

ALL APPLICANTS MUST:

- be 18 years of age or older
- be officially withdrawn from any K-12 school system
- attend GED Orientation/Registration in person at Lake Technical Center
- present a Florida driver's license or Florida photo identification at Orientation/Registration
- present Original Social Security card NOT A COPY at Orientation/Registration
- pay a fee of \$50 CASH ONLY to purchase your seat at a GED test session.

ANY APPLICANT WHO IS 16 OR 17 YEARS OF AGE MUST ALSO:

- attend GED Preparatory classes (sites available throughout Lake County)
- receive verification of skill levels from the classroom instructor
- be officially withdrawn from school for at least one month
- provide instructor with an official withdraw form
- receive written approval from district personnel (Early Testing Waiver)
- 16 year old applicants must also provide a hardship letter written and signed by their parent to be attached to the Early Testing Waiver mentioned above. The application is sent for approval by Lake County Schools. Upon receipt of the signed authorization from the Lake County Schools District Office the applicant can attend orientation and set a date for the GED test

REMINDER: Once a student is pre-qualified by meeting the above requirements to take the OFFICIAL GED test they must attend orientation before they select a test date. Testers need to bring an official State of Florida ID with photograph (example: Florida driver's license), an original NOT A COPY of their social security card and fifty dollars (\$50) CASH ONLY to purchase their seat for the OFFICIAL GED TEST SESSION. NO CELL PHONES OR ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE ALLOWED IN THE TESTING CENTER....NO EXCEPTIONS!
